*Government Rules for the Parking Garage*

## **NOTICE TO ALL BUS OPERATORS**

### **421.3 - Conformity with signs and emergency directions**

Official signs of a prohibitory or directory nature and the directions of uniformed police officers or Bureau of Reclamation employees shall be complied with.

### **BUS GARAGE PROCEDURES**

- Loading and unloading of passengers - Time limit not to exceed ten minutes.
- Operators will back into holding stalls after unloading passengers. No passenger will be permitted to leave the bus once it is backed up and parked.
- Operators must inform passengers to stay on the sidewalk and not to walk in the area where buses are entering or leaving.
- Operators will hook up the exhaust hose or turn the motor off while parked in a holding stall, and unhook before leaving the garage. As a matter of safety to visitors and parking attendants, operators may be asked during peak periods to turn off their engines.
- There is a fee for all buses entering the Parking Garage to discharge or pick up passengers. This fee must be paid upon arrival or in accordance with arrangements made in writing with the Bureau of Reclamation.
