27-a: Thank you for your response. Your comment regarding noise has been noted and was addressed in Section 3.16.3 (Noise, Environmental Consequences and Mitigation Measures). Noise impacts were identified as significant under Alternative 2 for Salt Flat. Specific mitigation measures to Impact 3.16.1 were identified to reduce these impacts to less than significant and include SF-1a, SF1-b, SF-1c and SF1d. No additional response on the noise concern is required.

In addition, your comment regarding dust is addressed in Section 3.12.2 (Air Quality, Environmental Consequences and Mitigation Measures). Air quality impacts were identified as significant under Alternative 2 for Salt Flat. Mitigation measures SF-1a was developed to reduce this impact to less than significant. No additional response on the air quality concern is required.
