





We have reviewed the Environmental Assessment/Draft Environmental Impact Report (EA/DEIR) drafted for the Trinity River Bridges Project. Our review focused on water quality related issues covered in the EA/DEIR documents.

The EA/DEIR covers water quality objectives listed in the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control Plan (Basin Plan) intended to protect Trinity River beneficial uses. It appears that Basin Plan information was used to develop mitigation measures for minimizing water quality impacts.

At this time we do not have any specific comments regarding the proposed project based on the information provided. If new information deems additional mitigation measures necessary we will address these in upcoming permits required for the proposed project. We will also be drafting adequate monitoring and reporting programs. Permits required for the project have also been discussed in the EA/DEIR. We will issue these permits after we receive completed applications and required fees.
