## **Notice of Availability**

Dear Interested Party:

This is to inform you of the availability of the Plan Formulation Report (PFR) for the San Luis Drainage Feature Re-evaluation and EIS. The PFR includes a description of four alternatives, including the proposed action, for providing drainage service for the San Luis Unit of the Central Valley Project. An Executive Summary has also been prepared.

The PFR will serve as a source document as Reclamation works with cooperating agencies and stakeholders to further evaluate the alternatives. Over the next year and a half, Reclamation will prepare an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS). Public scoping meetings are scheduled in:
