The meeting is devoted entirely to development of the comprehensive research and management program identified by the AMWG at the January 29, 2003 meeting. The HBC Ad Hoc Group has developed an interim report for your consideration and requests you provide feedback on completion of the report. The Ad Hoc Group will continue to work on the comprehensive program, including project proposals and projected budgets, and will have updated versions available for the AMWG on May 29. In addition to the report, background information on humpback chub and the recovery goals for that endangered species will be provided by Steve Gloss, Carl Walters, and Rich Valdez. The concept of a recovery implementation plan has been discussed previously by the AMWG, so Clayton Palmer will make a presentation relating his experiences with the Upper Colorado Recovery Implementation Program. No discussion or consideration of a recovery implementation plan has yet been had by the Technical Work Group, but it seemed appropriate for the AMWG to learn more about this concept. The final discussion of the day, at 4 p.m., is included for the AMWG to consider all aspects of the preceding discussions and to provide global feedback to the HBC Ad Hoc Group.
