GCMRC would like to request time on the agenda for the February 26-27 TWG meeting. We have a backlog of important briefings and updates to present to the TWG and we are hoping that we can get these five items on the agenda for February. The items we request that you place on the agenda are as follows:

1. A presentation (preferably on Feb. 26) by Josh Korman and Carl Walters on target setting (90 minutes).
2. A presentation (preferably on Feb. 27) by Josh Korman on the graphical user interface (GUI) (30 minutes).
3. A presentation by Rebecca Cole's Asian tapeworm effects on humpback chub (60 minutes).
4. A presentation by Jack Schmidt on the physical component of the Summer 2000 LSSF (45 minutes).
5. A presentation by Robert Webb on the advanced conceptual model and an update on the coarse-grained sediment monitoring project (45 minutes).

On a different topic, GCMRC would like to request TWG support for changing the dates for the 2003 Science Symposium to the week of April 22. This is a bit later than the original plan approved by TWG, but a variety of factors, including Spring break conflicts for several of our potential university-based speakers, cause us to request this change. I am sorry to be a problem for you, but we need to get these dates nailed down so that we can reserve the meeting venue (Tucson is the city of choice), make firm plans, and line up our speakers. Could you please poll the TWG by email and see if they will support making this change in the 2003 Science Symposium dates?
