My family has enjoyed recreational activities on both Lake Powell & Lake Mead for the past 30 years. We relocated to Boulder City, Nevada to be closer to Lake Mead in 2021. Not allowing the public to access the lakes with motorized water vehicles is not an option. Doing so is akin to closing the Grand Canyon; these are national parks.

I find it very sad that nothing has been done to slow the release of water from both Lake Powell & Lake Mead before now. The drought conditions have existed for a decade yet nothing has changed. We have seen the lower portion of the Colorado River flowing at levels higher than ever this past year.
