Good afternoon. My name is Michael Flannigan and I am the Senior Vice President of Global Government Affairs for Peabody Energy. Peabody Energy operates the Kayenta Mine that provides coal to the Navajo Generating Station (NGS). We were recently informed of upcoming decisions that could have adverse impacts at the NGS which would have negative economic and employee impacts at the Kayenta Mine. We are meeting with representatives from the Navajo Nation and the Central Arizona Project (CAP) this week to get a better understanding of the role electricity from NGS plays in making the CAP successful and how Peabody and our 300 plus employees at the Kayenta Mine can help keep NGS operating.

During a meeting today with the Navajo they suggested that we meet with you to discuss how we can secure the support of the Bureau of Reclamation to protect the employees at NGS and the Kayenta Mine.
