Kristin,

Thanks for the follow up.

While Peabody continues to work and communicate closely with the tribes and Reclamation across the work streams, we believe reducing the cost of fuel rests on Peabody's shoulders.

Our initial firm 2025 pricing proposal to the NGS participants substantially reduced fuel costs and uncertainty, however, was based on preliminary mine plans and assumptions given the urgency of the request from SRP. We are aggressively working internally on a complete set of refined mine plans to deliver the quality, volume and pricing that will support the competitiveness of NGS in the southwest power market. We continue to take measures to optimize costs prior to and beyond 2025. Peabody will present our most current view of fuel costs at the April 12 meeting.

Look forward to the meeting on April 12th.
