Maureen D. Wambeke is the Information Resources Manager for the Great Plains Region. Wambeke is the Regional manager of Information Technology, Records, and Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) Programs. She is responsible for IT security, certification and accreditation activities, implementation of new technology, upgrading and maintaining current technology, data and communications network integrity, Hydromet water modeling, Microsoft Active Directory, user support training, WEB infrastructure, server administration, database management, and video conferencing implementation, FOIA activities, and records management.

Wambeke began her career with Reclamation in 1991 when she was hired under the Outstanding Scholar Program and was the Region's first Team Leader. She then worked as a management/budget analyst for several years before becoming an Oracle Database Administrator (DBA) in 1995. In 2000, Wambeke became a Novell Certified Network Engineer (CNE) and in 2004 became the supervisor for server administration, user support and training and database management. She became the Regional Chief Information Officer in January 2010 and the Information Resources Manager in 2013.

Wambeke graduated with a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration with an option in Information Systems in 1991 from Montana State University Billings. She is an Oracle DBA and Novell CNE and holds an Associate of Project Management Professional.
