I only cook w/ the filtered water so I always have to make sure the filter is replaced & stays full of water. I don't let my kids take a bath in the yellow water which is hard w/ a 21 month old & a newborn. The water is turning our whites yellow & makes all the clothes look worse after they get washed than before. We're basically paying twice for water, either to filter it again or to replace the clothes. For a family of six, or any family that really needs it. My hope is that the water issue of Glenbuen greatly improves. The issues listed here are limited, there is too many more to list from household cleaning to hygiene & feeling clean after showers.
