




COLORADO WATER TRUST

- ◆Denver-based non-profit working **statewide** to restore flows to Colorado's rivers in need
- ◆Form ed in 2001 to partner with Colorado's Instream Flow Program and amplify its work, which began in 1973
- ♦ Work with water users to put together **voluntary** transactions to benefit the environment
- ◆ Transactions are **flexible** temporary or permanent, split-season, ATM
- ♦ Work within the prior appropriation system and compensate water users at fair-market value or provide opportunity for tax benefits or donations



15-MILE REACH PROJECT

Collaboration with Grand Valley Water Users Association and Orchard Mesa Irrigation District to deliver water to the **Grand Valley Power** Plant when it benefits endangered fish in the 15-Mile Reach





Agreement enables CWT, GVWUA and OMID coordinate deliveries up to 5000 AF/year



In exchange, CWT provided \$425,000 to OMID and GVWUA for New Vinelands Power Plant



2019 – 2021 OPERATIONS

	2019	2020	2021
Amount of CWT Water Delivered	328 AF	1200 AF	4500 AF

2021 RECAP:

- Release rate of 50-100 c.f.s.
- Volume limited to 5000 acre-feet
- Releases in July-September
- Water acquired from:
 - Town of Palisade (200 AF)
 - River District (1000 AF)
 - Caerus (2000 AF purchased, 1300 AF donated)





2022 Capacity



- Operations limited awaiting completion of New Vinelands Power Plant
- Up to 5000 AF available for acquisition and delivery when 15-Mile Reach flows below Recovery Program flow targets
- Significant interest from corporate donors
- Beyond 2022: Finding sources within and beyond Ruedi Reservoir
