**Facility Affected:** Canyon Ferry Reservoir

**River Affected:** Missouri River

**Condition Description**

Current Conditions – Canyon Ferry Dam and Reservoir as of 2:00 p.m. July 19, 2011.

- Elevation = 3798.51 feet (1.51 feet into the exclusive flood control pool, 50.9% utilized)
- Storage = 1,943,181 acre-feet
- Inflow = 13,640 cubic-feet per second (cfs)
- Discharge = 13,440 cfs (to the Missouri River)

**Releases from the Canyon Ferry Reservoir to the Missouri River are being maintained at 13,440 cfs.**

**In accordance with the Emergency Action Plan for Canyon Ferry Dam, Reclamation is no longer in an elevated response level requiring notifications to downstream affected agencies. Operational notifications will continue to be posted to the internet while the reservoir remains in the flood pool.**

**1. Potential River Levels and Times of Arrival**

The following provides the approximate travel times from Dam to reach key locations along the Missouri River:

<u>Missouri River Location</u>	<u>Approximate Travel Time</u>	<u>Approximate Stage Increase</u>
Craig	7 hours 45 min	n/a
Cascade	13 hours 15 min	n/a
Ulm	18 hours 30 min	n/a
Great Falls	25 hours 00 min	n/a

**2. Actions Taken by Reclamation**

Inflows into Canyon Ferry have peaked and are trending downward. The releases to the Missouri River from Canyon Ferry Dam and Powerplant are being maintained at approximately 13,440 cfs to control the reservoir elevation.

**3. Actions Expected of Downstream Agencies**

Downstream agencies should take these flows into account combined with existing downstream tributary flows entering the Missouri River and notify landowners who occupy low lying areas that they are subject to potential flooding.
