### **Parking**

The City of Billings parking garages, Park One and Park Three, are located within two blocks of the building facility. Park One is located on  $3^{rd}$  Ave. North between N.  $29^{th}$  Street and N.  $30^{th}$  Street. Park Three is located on  $2^{nd}$  between N. Broadway and N.  $27^{th}$  Street. The rates in the city garages are  $35\phi$  an hour for the first two hours and \$1 an hour after that, with a \$5 daily maximum charge.
