Parking

The City of Billings parking garages, Park One and Park Three, are located within two blocks of the building facility. Park One is located on 3^{rd} Ave. North between N. 29^{th} Street and N. 30^{th} Street. Park Three is located on 2^{nd} between N. Broadway and N. 27^{th} Street. The rates in the city garages are 35ϕ an hour for the first two hours and \$1 an hour after that, with a \$5 daily maximum charge.
