Subject: **Canyon Ferry Water Release Order - CFR No. 15-10**

CURRENT RESERVOIR CONDITIONS:

Elevation: 3785.39; Storage: 1,518,733 acre-feet; River Release: 4,700 cfs; Inflow: 3,440 cfs;

GENERAL COMMENTS:

Releases from Canyon Ferry will be reduced to meet targeted reservoir elevations by early spring. Also, turbine releases are restricted and limited to a 2-unit capacity until March 12th. In response, the following operation changes are required at Canyon Ferry Dam and Powerplant.

CANYON FERRY RELEASES AND OPERATIONS: Times are Mountain Standard Time (MST)

At 0100 hour on Monday, March 9, 2015:

*Decrease releases through the river outlet gates to 880 cfs.
Maintain releases through the spillway gates at 0 cfs.
Maintain turbine release at $\approx 3,620$ cfs (≈ 36 MW-Hr/hr using 101.8 cfs/mw).
Maintain release for Helena Valley Project at 0 cfs.
Decrease release to the Missouri River to 4,500 cfs.
Decrease total release from Canyon Ferry to 4,500 cfs.*

At 1630 hour on Thursday, March 12, 2015:

*Decrease releases through the river outlet gates to 0 cfs.
Maintain releases through the spillway gates at 0 cfs.
Increase turbine release to $\approx 4,500$ cfs (≈ 44 MW-Hr/hr using 101.8 cfs/mw).
Maintain release for Helena Valley Project at 0 cfs.
Maintain release to the Missouri River at 4,500 cfs.
Maintain total release from Canyon Ferry at 4,500 cfs*
