

L.A. POWER, LIGHT OFFICIALS HERE

L. A. Men to Select Site of Boulder City Camp For Power Line Work

A party of 16 officials of the Los Angeles bureau of power and light, arrived in Las Vegas this morning and during their stay here will select the site for another camp at Boulder City, which will be used in the construction of the power line by the city of Los Angeles.

According to the officials of the bureau, the new camp will make room for the employment of about 150 additional men, and these will be placed at work as soon as accommodations can be made for them.

Williams, of the electrical workers' union in Los Angeles; Joe Shulman, Leo Strome, H. W. Grave, James Doorley and Duke Hammond, all employes of the department of water and power.
