

Dam Worker Dies

In 90 Foot Fall

Harry Morgan, 32, was fatally injured this morning when he fell 90 feet, off the Nevada intake tower, and was so badly crushed that he died an hour after the accident, without regaining consciousness.

Morgan, who was a form stripper for Six Companies and employed on the job since August 14, 1932, lost his balance while standing on the edge of the tower and crashed down the tower to the concrete floor below. He was rushed to the hospital, but died despite efforts to save his life.

Deceased came to Boulder City from Globe, Arizona, and is survived by a widow and a daughter, the latter about a year old.

The body of the dead man is at the Parks Mortuary and funeral services will be announced later.
