

All American Canal Chief Engineer Dies

PHOENIX, Ariz., July 7 (U.P.)—
The scheduled conference to iron out the inter-state dispute over the construction of the Parker dam, was cancelled today by the death of Raymond Priest, of Yuma, chief engineer of the all-American canal who died of heart attack last night.

Priest had come to Phoenix to confer with Governor B. B. Moeur, in connection with the distribution of the waters of the Colorado river. He was one of the best known engineers of the southwest.
