

# Pat M'Carran Arrives Today For Dam Meet

United States Senator Pat McCarran was scheduled to arrive at Las Vegas airport this afternoon by Western Air Express to spend several days in southern Nevada.

Although the mission that called the junior senator west was the dedication of the plaque on Boulder dam in memory of the workmen who gave their lives in its building, he expected to spend considerable time attending to other matters in which he is interested.

The senator was expected to be the guest of the Las Vegas Eagles lodge at their regular meeting this evening, and was to spend the entire day tomorrow in the Moapa and Virgin Valleys going over the work accomplished by the CCC camps, and conferring with the Virgin group about the proposed water system they hope to build as a PWA project.

Thursday, the senator expects to confer with labor leaders in attendance at the meeting of the state federation's executive committee, and then proceed to the dam to deliver the address of the day in honor of "gold star" workmen who have died in action on the Boulder dam front.

His plans for the remainder of the week are indefinite, although it is expected he might continue north to Reno to take care of some matters there before returning to the national capital.
