

All Cars Halted At Dam Gate Now

All cars arriving at the reservation gate, Boulder City, will be stopped from now on for inspection, W. H. Trimble, chief ranger of the Boulder police department, announced this morning.

Rangers will not be allowed to differentiate between residents of Boulder City and visitors to the dam community. All cars, regardless of their occupants, are to be stopped, Trimble said today. This measure is being put into effect to protect the residents of Boulder in order that transients coming to town will be given transient's privileges only.

Trimble said today, that with the laying off of workers on the Boulder canyon project, persons still have passes to the reservation who are not entitled to them.
