

BOULDER LAKE BECOMES DEEPER

The elevation of Boulder lake, according to the flow of the Colorado river, is showing a rise of an average of six tenths of a foot daily, reclamation engineers said this morning.

Today the river was flowing at the rate of 22,000 cubic feet per second, and 20,260 cubic feet per second is being released from the lake.

The elevation of the ever-growing body of water this morning was 925.4.
