

# Cashman Ferry to Resume Operations

The Cashman ferry across the Colorado river, joining the Nevada and Arizona Boulder dam highways, will be in operation again tonight following an enforced two day layoff, officials of the company announced.

Reports that the ferry had sunk with three cars aboard Sunday evening, were erroneous, bureau of reclamation and ferry company officials declared.

Due to a slight accident, which temporarily incapacitated the ferry, it was necessary to make a forced landing on the Nevada side, some distance below the regular landing. There were three cars and a truck on the ferry at the time, but all were landed without difficulty.
