

# Fish Hatchery For Lake Gets Setback

Southern Nevada's federal fish hatchery to aid in stocking of Boulder dam lake received a setback today when the house of representatives conferees refused to agree to the allocation of \$60,000 for this purpose which had been previously approved by the senate.

News of the failure came from Senator Pat McCarran, who wired as follows: "My amendment to the deficiency appropriation bill carrying \$60,000 for a fish hatchery in southern Nevada was eliminated by the house of representatives conferees.

"I will offer the amendment again in the senate to the next deficiency appropriation bill which comes up quite soon. I am assured of its adoption by the senate appropriations committee of which I am a member."
