

Okeh for Dam Stamp Is Seen In Near Future

The proposed Boulder dam stamp, to be issued in commemoration of the completion of the Boulder canyon project, will in all probability be authorized by Postmaster-General Farley in the near future, according to the New York Sun.

The request that such a stamp be issued was laid before the postmaster-general by Senator Key Pittman upon recommendation of Postmaster F. F. Garside of Las Vegas, and has been under consideration for some time, the Sun says.

It is argued, the New York newspaper points out, that the engineering project is national in scope and that its completion should receive special recognition.

Engineers in charge of the construction of Boulder dam estimate that it will be put in operation late this summer, the article points out, and it is taken for granted that the formal dedication exercises will take place at the time.

All senators and congressmen from the Colorado river basin are solidly backing the request of Senator Pittman, and the Sun predicts the stamp will be issued.
