

BOULDER LAKE IS SWIMMER MECCA

The now 80 mile long Boulder lake furnished an attractive mecca for swimming and boating enthusiasts of southern Nevada yesterday, with the Nevada shores of the recently formed body of water dotted with swimmers, bathers, and boating parties.

The elevation of the lake this morning was 916.3, indicating a drop of 6 tenths over Thursday's report. The flow of the Colorado river is dropping, and water was entering the lake today at the rate of 37,500 cubic feet per second. Water is being released thru the slide gate valves in number one diversion tunnel at the rate of 15,000 cubic feet per second.
