

Boulder Lake Is Holding Its Own

Boulder lake was just "holding its own" today with the narrow margin between the inflow and the outflow of the Colorado river.

At Bright Angel this morning the Colorado was running at the rate of 10,300 cubic feet per second, a drop of 800 cubic feet per second over yesterday's report. With water at the rate of 10,280 cubic feet per second being released from the lake via diversion tunnel number one, only 20 cubic feet per second were left in the lake for storage purposes.
