

Hatchery Expert Is Viewing Sites

C. R. Lucas, bureau of fisheries expert from Salt Lake City, is spending the day in the Moapa Valley today looking over various sites suggested as satisfactory for the proposed hatchery to be located in this area to stock Boulder Lake.

Lucas was taken thru the valley by Col. Thomas B. Miller, senior superintendent for the park service's CCC camps, and three sites were picked out as possible locations for the hatchery, Miller states.

Lucas was sent in at the request of Congressman James G. Scrugham, who is working to have the \$60,000 appropriation originally contained in the second deficiency appropriation bill replaced in a later measure.

The hatchery expert is expected to be in Las Vegas this evening and to spend considerable time here conferring with officials of the fish and game protective association and other interested parties.
