

# August Is Second In Tourist Count

Tourist travel to Boulder dam amounted to 34,218 persons for the month of August, putting that month in second place for high tourist travel so far this year, a check with the Boulder police department revealed today. The figure includes those who were admitted to the Boulder dam reservation by the western entrance and those who came via the Black canyon ferry.

The total number topped yesterday's estimates by 618, a check shows. The only month so far this year that rules in supremacy over last month in rate of tourist travel is February, when 39,884 visitors came to view the stupendous Boulder canyon project.

During the month of August a total of 2,076 visitors in 720 cars was admitted to Boulder City via the Black canyon ferry, it was announced today.
