

# 3,000 SHRINERS TO LEAD TOURIST HORDE INTO DAM AREA SATURDAY

Local Nobles to Leave for  
Yermo Ceremonial To-  
morrow at Two

**CARS ARE SOUGHT**

Special Trains to Arrive  
In Boulder Early Sun-  
day Morning

The biggest week-end in Las Vegas and Boulder City tourist history loomed large on the horizon this afternoon as the twin cities prepared to welcome the Shrine hosts from Los Angeles who will swarm into the Boulder dam area starting tomorrow night.

Some three thousand or more fezzed Nobles will descend on the two communities aboard train, plane and automobile and will spend one full day viewing the wonders of Boulder dam and the new inland lake and making whoopee in the hot spots of Las Vegas.

**THE DEPARTURE** of some 30 Shriners from Las Vegas and Boulder City will be the signal for the start of the celebration, as it is hoped by those making the trek to Yermo, where a giant ceremonial will be staged, to bring back half a hundred or more Los Angeles Shriners with them on the return home.

Mike Silver, in charge of the transportation facilities for the journey to Yermo, has requested that all possible cars be available for the use of the Shriners from here, declaring that "the more cars we can get to go down to Yermo, the more Shriners we can bring back with us."

**IT IS THE** plan to take as many Shriners from here as possible down in local autos and then, after the ceremonial, to transfer the auto loads of Vegas and Boulder Shriners onto the special trains and bring the visiting Shriners back in the autos.

The local contingent will gather at the Sal Sagev hotel at two o'clock tomorrow afternoon and will leave for the southland immediately thereafter. All Shriners are requested to be on time so that the party can get away as early as possible.

Silver has requested that all those who are willing to take their autos contact him by phoning 58J and those who have no transportation are asked to inform Silver so he will know how many to make reservations for.

**THE UNION PACIFIC** special trains—10 of them—are expected to reach Yermo about five o'clock tomorrow afternoon and the Shriners aboard will take to the desert where the ceremonial will be held. Immediately following the rites, the special trains will head for Las Vegas and Boulder City, arriving in the latter community about four o'clock.

Sunday morning plans have been made to take the visitors over the dam and for a trip on Boulder lake, and as soon as this treat is over the Nobles will descend on Las Vegas.

**IT IS PLANNED** to run one special train every half hour or so, from Boulder City to Las Vegas, from eight o'clock on, to allow those who desire to come to Las Vegas.

The special trains will depart from Las Vegas about nine o'clock Sunday night.
