

DRIFTWOOD AT DAM ELIMINATED

Large quantities of driftwood in Boulder Lake have been practically eliminated following a month's work on the part of national parks service employes and workmen of Grand Canyon Airlines, Incorporated, it was stated in Boulder City.

The two crews which have been working in the lake area for the past several weeks have boomed practically all the driftwood brought down from forest areas by the Colorado river, and the crews have confined the menace to little used canyon ways, it was stated.

Driftwood has seasonally presented a problem to boatmen ever since cruising on the world's largest man-made lake became a major phase of Boulder City's tourist industry. Murl Emery, official of Grand Canyon Airlines, said today that with the final removal of the large quantity of driftwood occasioned by the tremendous inflow of the river into the lake has made the way clear for operation of the Hualapai, new 44 foot special built custom cruiser, the largest and most elaborate boat used in lake service.
