



# Modern City of 3,500 Population Rises in Desert at Hoover Dam

---

One of the great preparatory works at the Hoover dam was the converting of a barren desert into a modern city already occupied by 3,500 people. Boulder City is now a completed enterprise, the newest and best built city in the world.

Water is pumped from the Colorado river to an elevation of 2,000 feet and carried thru six miles of pipe. A modern sanitary system was installed and complete sewer connections made. Paving of the streets is about completed and fire and police protection have been provided.

The government has constructed a large administration building, an employes' dormitory and a municipal building to house the city offices and the postoffice. Also sixty six residences for government employes.

In Boulder City the Six Companies, Inc., has constructed its own office building, ten dormitories, a huge mess hall capable of seating 1,200 men, a modern store building, clubhouse, garage, laundry, machine shop and many other buildings. For the married employes 358 residences of modern design have been completed and fifty others are under construction.
