

# BOULDER NIGHT AT HELLDORADO TO BE FEATURE

## Arizona Elks to Increase Crowd at Fete; Trip to Dam Planned

Saturday, April 27, third day of the Helldorado celebration, has been announced as Boulder City day, by the executive committee of the big show. Hundreds of Elks and their ladies, including a solid delegation of several hundred from the Arizona state convention being held at Kingman, will arrive on that day. Six Companies is cooperating in its usual public spirited manner. Frank Crowe of the Six Companies is providing the big transports which will take all visiting Elks and their ladies on a sightseeing trip which will be personally conducted by G. E. Bodell, chief special agent for Six Companies.

The caravan will leave Las Vegas at 9:30 a. m. on April 27, arrive Boulder City and start the trip at 10 a. m. sharp which will take the party to the lower portals for a view of the power house construction. From there the party will go back to the top of the world's greatest dam, and cross over to the Arizona side. The tour will continue to the Babcock-Wilcox plant, on to Observation Point, there to view the lake in the distance, then will return to Boulder City. All those who wish can then take a boat trip to the face of the dam, there to view the upstream side, the intake towers and diversion gates, returning at 2 p. m. for lunch at Anderson's mess hall.

**THE AFTERNOON** will be topped off with a spirited burro baseball contest between Boulder City Stray Elks and the Las Vegas Elks. Special Agent Bodell makes only one request and that for the sake of safety, that no person try to board or leave the huge transports while they are in motion and also states that no private cars will be allowed to enter the canyon on that day.

Saturday is Boulder City night at Helldorado, when every citizen of the neighboring city who is not on duty will trek his way to the Pioneer Village in Las Vegas and make merry with the thousands of revelers who will be in attendance at Nevada's greatest celebration. Special features honoring the Boulder City crowd are being arranged and this night is expected to rival all others in attendance.
