

Ask Supreme Court to Approve Dam

WASHINGTON, March 9.—(I.N. S.)—The Supreme Court today was asked to remove any possible legal barrier to building of the vast Boulder Dam project by dismissing Arizona's suit to declare the congressional act authorizing construction invalid.

The government and six western states joined in the plea.

Arizona is opposed by California, New Mexico, Colorado, Utah, Nevada and Wyoming, which entered into a six-state compact for division of the impounded waters of the Colorado.
