

2 Workers Suffer

Fracture In Crash

John Abercrombie, 27, and Oscar Williams, oiler, are lying in the Boulder City hospital suffering skull injuries as the result of an automobile accident which occurred at 3 p. m. Saturday on the wash highway just above Williamsville when an Anderson brothers speedwagon sideswiped a Six Company one and half ton Ford truck which was carrying a load of men.

Abercrombie and Williams, truck driver and oiler respectively, are in serious condition, and news as to their probable recovery is of necessity indefinite, as is usually the case after skull fracture.

Jim Holmes, Alvin Erickson and Carson Brooks, injured slightly, were given treatment and released immediately from the hospital, while the other two are yet in a serious condition.

The speedwagon sideswiped the truck as it passed it, going in the same direction.
