

# Steel Fence Is Built at Gateway

A steel "corral" in which to keep confiscated cars is being built at the gate to the Hoover dam reservation.

The fence enclosure is being built on the north side of the highway, opposite the rangers' office. Excavation was done early in the week.

Police Chief G. E. Bodell today issued warning to motorists coming in at the gate, that machines must not be overloaded. The natural intended carrying capacity of the machine must determine the maximum number of passengers

riding through the reservation gate, he said, pointing out that many of the accidents is caused by an overloaded car, especially a crowded front seat.
