

# Labor Tests to Be Made at Boulder

## Harvard Research Group Is Setting Up Machinery for Experiments

The Harvard research group, in Boulder City for the purpose of determining to what extent the heat of this desert section effects the working efficiency of humans, arrived yesterday and is expected to begin its series of experiments within the next few days.

The group is in charge of Dr. D. B. Dill and includes Doctors Talbert and Edwards, as assistants.

Dr. Talbert is acquainted in Boulder City, having come there several months ago to prepare for the experiments this summer.

A laboratory and study is to be established, probably in the municipal building and it is in this laboratory that most of the experiments will be conducted.

The subjects, which are to be studied, are the doctors themselves as the doctors are of the opinion that better results can be obtained by having a constant subject upon which to work.

The scientists will be here all summer on their research job.

The experiments at Boulder City are a portion of a series which have been conducted on Pikes Peak, Leadville and other communities, testing the working efficiency in various climates.

The men have a set of exercises which have been prescribed for the entire set of tests and have been used in all previous experiments. They will not perform the actual manual labor which is conducted at the river by the workmen.
