

L. A. FIRM LOW ON ESTIMATES FOR 30 HOUSES

Wide Variance of Bids Turned In By Sixteen Who Estimated Job

De Camp and Hudson com-
pany limited, a Los Angeles
firm was the low bidder for
construction of 30 houses to be
built by the reclamation bureau
at Boulder City, it was revealed
today when bids were opened in
the reclamation offices in Boul-
der City this morning. The bid
was for \$9,053.10.

There was a wide variance in
the 16 bids as they were turned in,
the lowest being the De Camp and
Hudson estimate, while the high-
est was presented by the English
Construction company of Washing-
ton, D. C., which was for \$48,860.
The next to the highest bid was
for some \$17,000.

THE WILLIAM C. Cannon com-
pany, of Pomona, was second low
with an estimate of \$10,837 with
George A. Whitmeyer and Sons
company, of Oden, with \$10,-
985, Carl F. Bengston, Boulder
City, \$11,230 and J. J. Baker and
J. N. Robbins, San Bernardino,
\$11,632, following in the order
named.

The bids were for 30 three-room
frame houses and these must all be
completed within 120 days after
notice to proceed has been given.
It is expected that some of the
structures will be completed in 90
days after the order has been is-
sued.

THE HOUSES will be used as
homes by members of the reclama-
tion bureau staff now residing in
Las Vegas, some in the govern-
ment camp and others in dormitor-
ies and other places in Boulder
City.
