Time was when Arizona senators were bucking the Hoover dam project in all its phases.

The time now has come when Arizona senators are battling shoulder to shoulder with solons from Nevada and other western states for funds some of which will help in construction of first class highways into the Hoover dam region through Arizona.

"Senator Carl Hayden has been making a great fight for greater appropriations for road building in the public land states, and it looks like he is winning his objective," the Mohave County Miner recently stated. "The bill had been passed by the house by a large majority."

How correct was Senator Hayden when he stated lack of roads in the past has done much to hold up various developments in the west.

Mohave county has pioneered in the project of connecting Arizona with Hoover dam by highway, by building a pioneer road. The movement is now becoming accelerated for construction by Arizona of a first class highway from Chloride to the Colorado, which stretch of road on day will be a unit of an excellent north-south highway through Arizona, Nevada and Idaho, through from Mexico to Canada.
