

They Salvage "Titanic" From the Spot She's Been Imbedded In Mud for Months

They salvaged the "Titanic" yesterday in the bottom of Black canyon, near the lower portals, where she has been imbedded in mud for months, since the dragline was dumped at the upper portals into 20 or 30 feet of water.

The "Titanic" is the big scow which the company used to use in hauling machinery and equipment on the river when the water held way in Black canyon, before she was diverted thru the Arizona diversion tunnels.

Several months ago a big dragline was dumped into the river when this scow upset near the Arizona bank at the end of a journey across the river with the drag-

Soon afterward the "Titanic" was sunk down between the lower portals, and for more than a month has been in the dead water there just upstream from where the river returns to its channel from the two diversion tunnels.

A dirt barrier was built around the downstream side of the one-third-buried scow and the water pumped from around her. The sand was dug from around the lower end. The lower half of the deck was torn off and replaced
