

TEMPERATURE IN BOULDER UNDER 100 FOR 4 DAYS

Unprecedented Cool Spell
For July Gives Workers
Relief from Heat

While dozens are dying in the middle west because of the heat, Boulder City and southern Nevada have enjoyed a comparatively cool week, which has had a freshening effect upon Hoover dam workers and others in Boulder City, as a rest from the greater heat of the few previous weeks.

Rising above 100 at no time this week, the temperature has hit around 98 at the highest this week.

On Tuesday and yesterday the thermometer touch 98 maximum, while on Wednesday the highest was 90 and on Thursday 95.

The nights, to have not been so hot, the thermometer falling as low as 66, on Tuesday night, and 68 Wednesday night.

Many Boulder residents have put quilts back into use this week, whereas they had been discarded for the summer previous to the cooling rainstorms of last week-end.
