

Concert Set for New Band Stand

Plans for the first open air band concert to be held at the new bandstand have been completed.

The concert has been set definitely for 5 p. m. Sunday evening, May 8, and will be a Mothers' day program, under sponsorship of the American Legion Auxiliary, with the new American Legion band making its third public appearance, in its first real concert.

Vocal selections will be rendered also by some of Boulder City's local talent.

In keeping with the significance of Mothers' day, the Auxiliary will sell carnations Saturday and Sunday, at stands in front of the Six Company mess hall, Boulder City Drug store, Browder's lunch and the Municipal building.

The new bandstand is on the southeast side of Nevada boulevard, just below Wyoming, south of the site of the new Legion hall, which is to be started immediately.
