Jack McPhee, most seriously injured of the three Boulder dam workmen who dropped 85 feet thru the spillway raise, into diversion tunnels number one early Tuesday morning, has contracted pneumonia as a result of his injuries and wild ride thru the tunnel to safety at the lower portal, according to word received from Boulder City today.

While his condition is not critical, his case is regarded as rather serious due to the injuries he received in falling.
