

Grand Canyon, L. V. Road Being Sought

Construction of a first class highway connecting the Grand canyon with the Boulder dam and Las Vegas thru the use of federal money from the national industrial recovery bill now pending before the senate, is the purpose of the measure introduced yesterday by United States Senator Pat McCarran which would establish a federal reservation over the area covered by the Boulder dam lake, and extending thru to the Grand canyon.

If this can be done, Senator McCarran points out, and the rights of the state of Nevada fully protected, it will bring several millions of dollars into Clark county as a result of the construction of this scenic highway, as well as diverting tourist travel into southern Nevada which is now going elsewhere.

"My whole object in the introduction of this bill," Senator McCarran says in a wire to President A. C. Grant of the Las Vegas chamber of commerce, "is the upbuilding of southern Nevada and the bringing of Clark county and Las Vegas to the attention of the traveling world by reason of the great federal project now in construction."
