

Mayor of L. A. And Party Visit Dam

Making his first visit to the Boulder Dam as the new Mayor of Los Angeles, Mayor Frank L. Shaw today visited the project, which will furnish Los Angeles with power and light in the future.

Mayor Shaw stated that this was his first visit to Las Vegas in 12 years, and he was accompanied by an official party on an inspection tour of the Los Angeles Municipal power line and the Boulder Dam. The party included John A. Eby, Arthur J. Mullen, A. F. Southwick and A. B. Prior, water and power commissioners of Los Angeles, E. F. Scattergood, chief electrical engineer and general manager of the Los Angeles bureau of power and lights, and several representatives of Los Angeles papers.

The official party will return to Los Angeles tomorrow, Mayor Shaw stated today.
