

Dam Area Survey Meet Postponed

The conference scheduled for Sunday, on the economic survey in connection with use of Boulder Dam power in this area, has been postponed until next week, it was announced today by President A. C. Grant of the Las Vegas chamber of commerce.

This action was taken upon receipt of word from B. F. Hewitt, senior geologist of the U.S.G.S., that he would be unable to reach here until Tuesday. Hewitt is in charge of the survey now being made, and is slated to go into various phases of the matter with chamber of commerce committees, George W. Malone and Ed W. Clark of the Nevada Colorado River Commission, and Dr. John A. Fulton, director of the Mackey School of Mines.

Principal among the topics of discussion will be the desirability of securing an additional allocation of funds to complete the work already started.

Dr. Fulton, when here recently, advised chamber of commerce officials that in order to "do the job right" more money would be necessary, and it is expected this can be secured if a proper presentation is made.
