

Miles Death Is

Said Accidental

Argrant Emmitt Miles met his death Monday afternoon as a result of accidental injuries in a drainage tunnel near Lookout Point, causing depressed fracture of the skull, according to the report of the coroner's jury, following an investigation made by Coroner Frank M. Ryan this morning.

It was further found that the accident was an avoidable one since Miles took a short cut on his way to work with four companions and went into a drain tunnel seven by eight feet in diameter and fell about 47 feet into a pit in the tunnel, located some 300 feet from the portal.

His companions with him said they heard him cry out and then heard two or three thumps as he struck the sides of the pit before landing in the bottom. They had refused to enter the tunnel with him.

Miles was removed from the pit and taken to the Boulder City hospital for treatment and lived four hours after arriving there.

He is survived by his widow, who will leave with the body tomorrow for Oakley, Utah, where burial services will be held.
