

# Foreman Is Injured By Falling Timber

F. J. Martin, foreman for Six Companies Inc., is at the Boulder City hospital painfully hurt. Dr. R. O. Schofield termed Martin's injury as a severe fracture of the skull.

Martin, according to all reports, was working on the Nevada wing of the power house, at the opening of one of the 15 foot tunnels leading from the upper Nevada penstock when he was struck by a falling timber.
