

# Jack Gives Way,

## Worker Loses Life

A falling jumbo yesterday crushed every spark of life from the body of Victor K. Auchard, 25, who was working in number three penstock tunnel, on the Arizona side, as a carpenter.

Auchard, it is learned, was one of a gang of men assisting in the moving of the huge jumbo structure in the tunnel. One of the jacks under the jumbo fell out, followed by the crashing of the structure. Auchard was caught beneath it and was horribly crushed. He died instantly, according to reports.

Auchard is survived by his widow, who resided in Las Vegas. Remains are at the Parks Mortuary, Boulder City, and will be sent to the deceased man's former home, Claycenter, Kansas. No funeral services are to be held here.

Mrs. Auchard was attending the theatre in Las Vegas when informed of her husband's fate, and collapsed, being taken to her home by friends.
