

Engineer Injured In Slide at Dam

Edgar Long, government engineer, suffered painful but not serious injuries last night when he is said to have slid nearly 75 feet while at work in the Nevada power tunnel. Long was suffering this morning from an injured knee and an injured left arm.

Fred Coffin, who was working in the same tunnel at the time, is said to have slid nearly 100 feet, and has an injured back and an injured hand. Both, after treatment, were released from the Boulder City hospital. Their injuries are not thought to be of serious nature.

The accident occurred at 10:30 o'clock last night, on swing shift, and the men were coming down the tunnel when the rope they were using broke.
